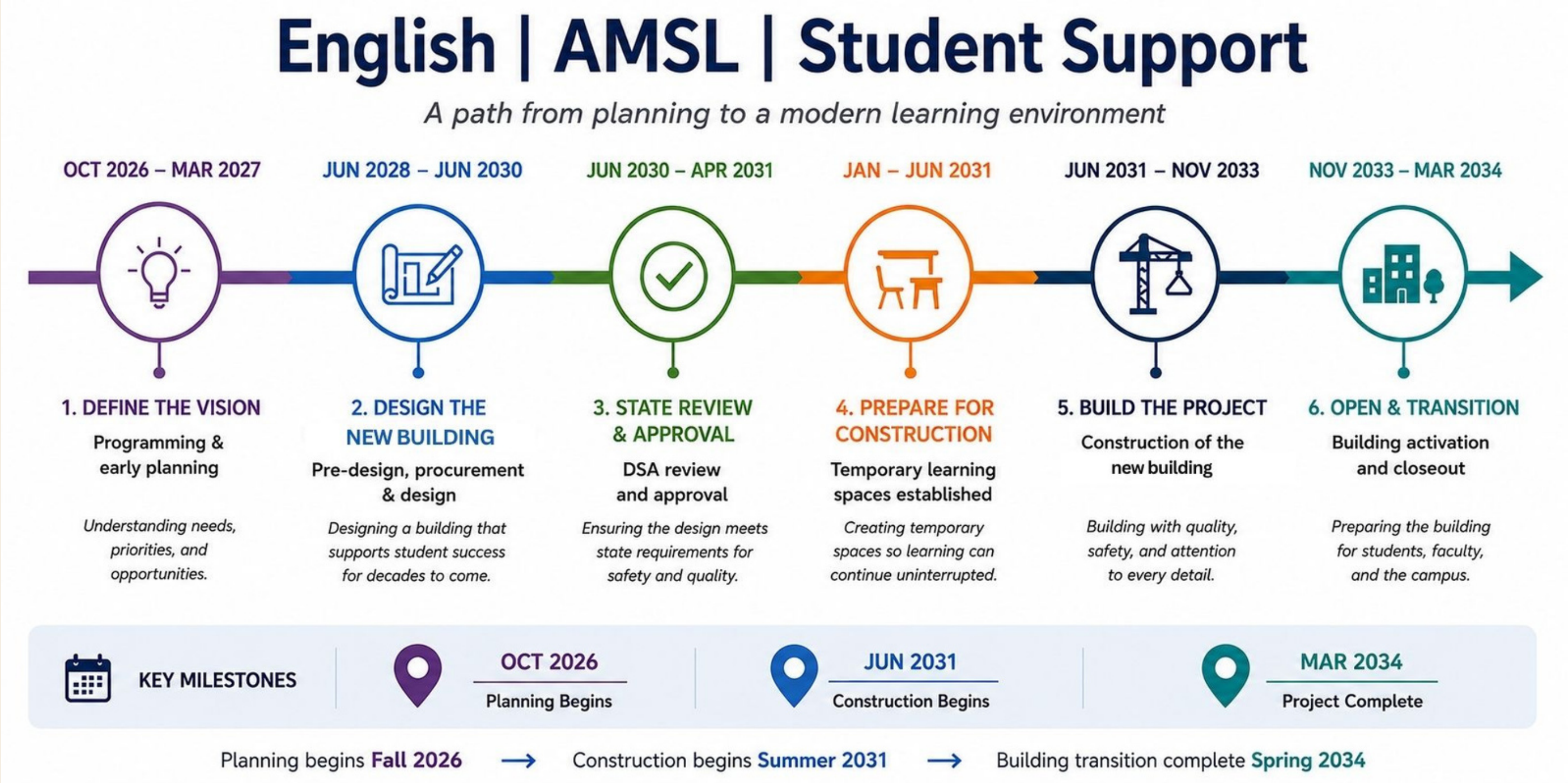

BARC Award Update

Beginning September 15, 2026, through October 30, 2026

- 1. Department submits a Requisition Request Form and vendor quote to Business Services: September 15, 2026 – October 30, 2026**
- 2. The BARC purchasing cycle closes and all quotes for approved items are due to Business Services no later than October 30, 2026.**
- 3. Requisitions are entered by Business Services and Purchase Orders are issued by the District Office: October 1, 2026- November 13, 2026**
- 4. Goods are ordered, received, and vendor paid December 2026 - February 2027.**

SAFETY PROCEDURES

Campus safety starts with YOU.



CALL COLLEGE POLICE
619-388-6405
OR CALL **911** FOR ALL EMERGENCIES

 **FIRE**

- Activate pull alarm
- Evacuate building to designated area
- Do not use elevators; use stairwells to evacuate
- Do not re-enter until all clear is given

 **EARTHQUAKE**

- Drop - Cover - Hold on
- After shaking stops, evacuate building to evacuation area
- Do not re-enter until all clear is given

 **CHEMICAL SPILL OR GAS SMELL**

- Evacuate building to evacuation area
- Avoid breathing fumes
- Alert to any medical needs
- Do not re-enter until all clear is given

 **MEDICAL EMERGENCY**

- Stay with the person until help arrives
- If able and needed, begin CPR and locate an AED
- Red call boxes and blue emergency phones are available on campus

 **POWER OUTAGE**

- Evacuate building if there is insufficient lighting
- Help others who may require assistance
- Preserve phone battery life

 **SUSPICIOUS BEHAVIOR / PERSON**

- Do not approach, provoke or obstruct the individual
- Distance yourself
- If something feels wrong, report it immediately

 **BOMB THREAT / SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE**

- Do not handle the object
- Clear the area
- Evacuate building to designated area
- Do not re-enter until all clear is given

 **ACTIVE SHOOTER**

- If you can locate a safe location, RUN (Evacuate)
- If you cannot get out, HIDE (Barricade)
- As a last resort, FIGHT (Take Action)
