### 1. *Jessica Thompson – One Faculty Campaign*

AFT is the national union. Local union worked to pass resolution to end two tier systems. Wanted to let people know about the campaign. Developed task force and legislative language to work toward this campaign. Continuing effort to eliminate two tier systems. Ideally everyone would be onboarded the same as all professors.
